

# EMERGENCY ACTION POLICY

The Team Manager & Coach shall:-

- Ensure you know that the first aider has an **FA FIRST AIDER** qualification that is in date.
- Ensure your first aid kit is with you and in date
- Ensure your mobile phone is available and charged
- Ensure you know the post code for the pitch you are playing at
- Ensure that you check your own player cards each game for player medical conditions and that it has an emergency contact number
- Ensure you have all player **MEDICAL EQUIPMENT** in a safe place for medical conditions.
- Ensure the match day environment is safe and appropriate for football
- Have a colleague who can support you should an incident occur
- Act in line with the FA First Aid Qualification should you need to
- After an incident return a club accident form to the club welfare officer

# EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

- Each team must have an identified **FA FIRST AIDER** prior to kick off
- Each player must have a carer to provide minor first aid
- There is a defibrillator at the front of the Egerton Youth Club building
- The post code of Egerton Youth Club is WA16 6SL
- You must have a mobile phone with you
- Identify at all times who will help you should an incident occur and ensure they are aware.
- If an incident occurs follow your **FA FIRST AIDER** qualification
- In an emergency dial 999 or 112 ( gives GPS to emergency services )
